Useful information

Getting to Valencia

By plane

Valencia international airport, which is located 8 Km away from city center, is connected with the main European airports.

Once at the airport, you can reach the city center by:

Metro:

Line 5 Aeropuerto / Marítim-Serreria. Approx. every 20 minutes.

Line 3 Aeropuerto / Palmaret- Rafelbunyol ([Metrovalencia](#)). Approx. every 20 minutes.

Fare to/from city center: approx. 3,90 € Journey time: ca. 30 minutes.

Bus:

Fernanbús, Line 150 Valencia – Manises – Aeropuerto: Timetable: Airport-Valencia: 6:30, 7:00, then every 30 minutes until 21:30 / 22:00.

Fare: approx. 1,40 €. Journey time: 40 minutes.

Taxi:

Flat fare from airport to Valencia (urban area): 20 €. Journey time: 20-25 minutes.

By train

Valencia is connected with Madrid and Barcelona by high-speed trains. Buying the tickets in advance (purchase on line, www.renfe.es) you can get discounts.

It takes 1 hour 40 minutes to travel from downtown Madrid (Atocha station) to Valencia city center (Joaquín Sorolla station), and about 3.30 hours from Barcelona (Sants station).

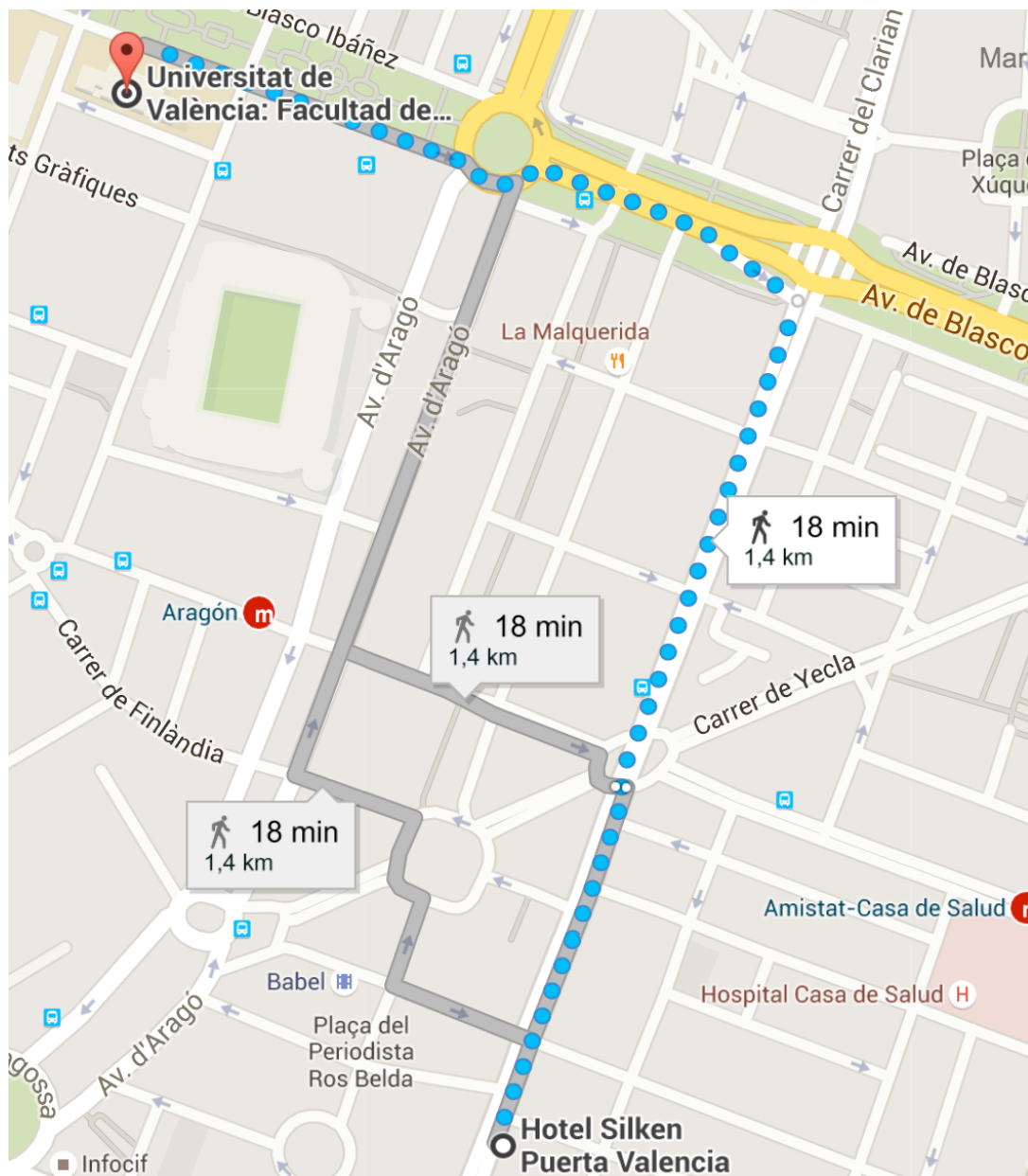
Getting to the main venue (for the venue on Sunday, see Maps and social program)

Venue: Facultat de Filologia, Av. Blasco Ibáñez, 32. València 46010

How to get there:

The city center as well as our suggested hotels are relatively near the venue.

From Silken Hotel: You can walk straight on Cardenal Benlloch street or on Av. d'Aragó until you reach Blasco Ibáñez avenue; turn left and walk straight you reach the Faculty (15-20 minutes).



- **By underground**

Line 3. Station “Facultats”. The stairs leading to the tube are located in front of the Faculty of History, scarcely 50 m. away from the Faculty of Philology, Translation and Communication.

Line 5. Station “Aragón”. The Faculty of Philology is located 7 minutes walk from Amadeo de Saboya exit, past the Football Stadium. Line 5, stop Amistat-Casa de Salud, leads to the Silken Puerta de Valencia hotel (5 minutes walk).

Line 3 also connects the campus with the city center (stations “Xativa”, “Colon” and “Alameda.”) Line 5 also connects the campus with the city center and North Train station (station Bailén), the main train station, Joaquin Sorolla (station Joaquin Sorolla-Jesús)

- **By bus**

The nearest stops are located in front of the main entrance of the Faculty of Philology, Translation and Communication. Line 89 (from Cardenal Benlloch Avenue) or lines 10, 12, 79 (from Av.-d’Aragó-Xile stop) (10 -15 min). To go back, take line 80 (in front of the main entrance of the Faculty of Philology).

A good (and fast) option is the Mensa at the Faculty of Philology (6 € coffee included for conference participants).

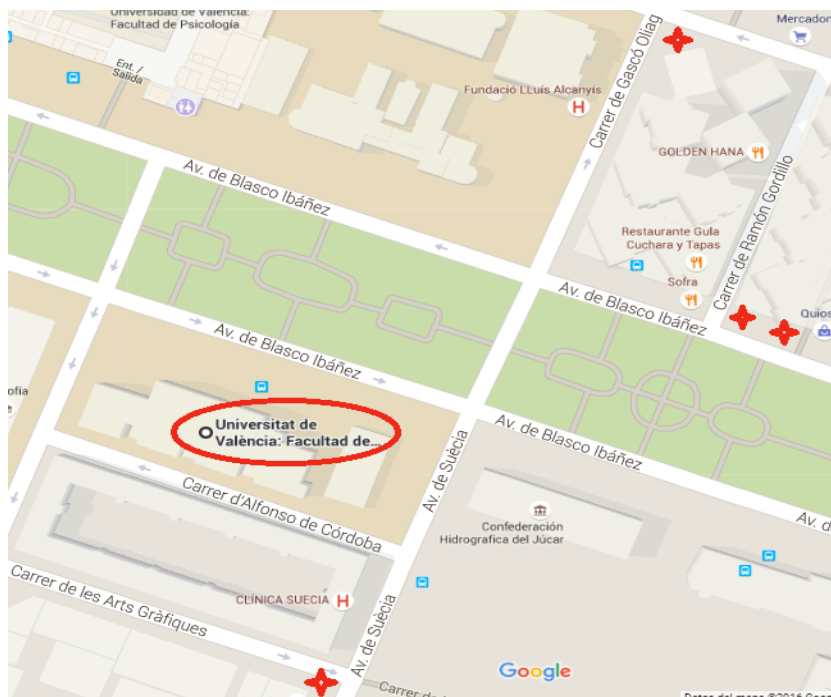
