LPTS 2016 Conference (Discourse Relational Devices)

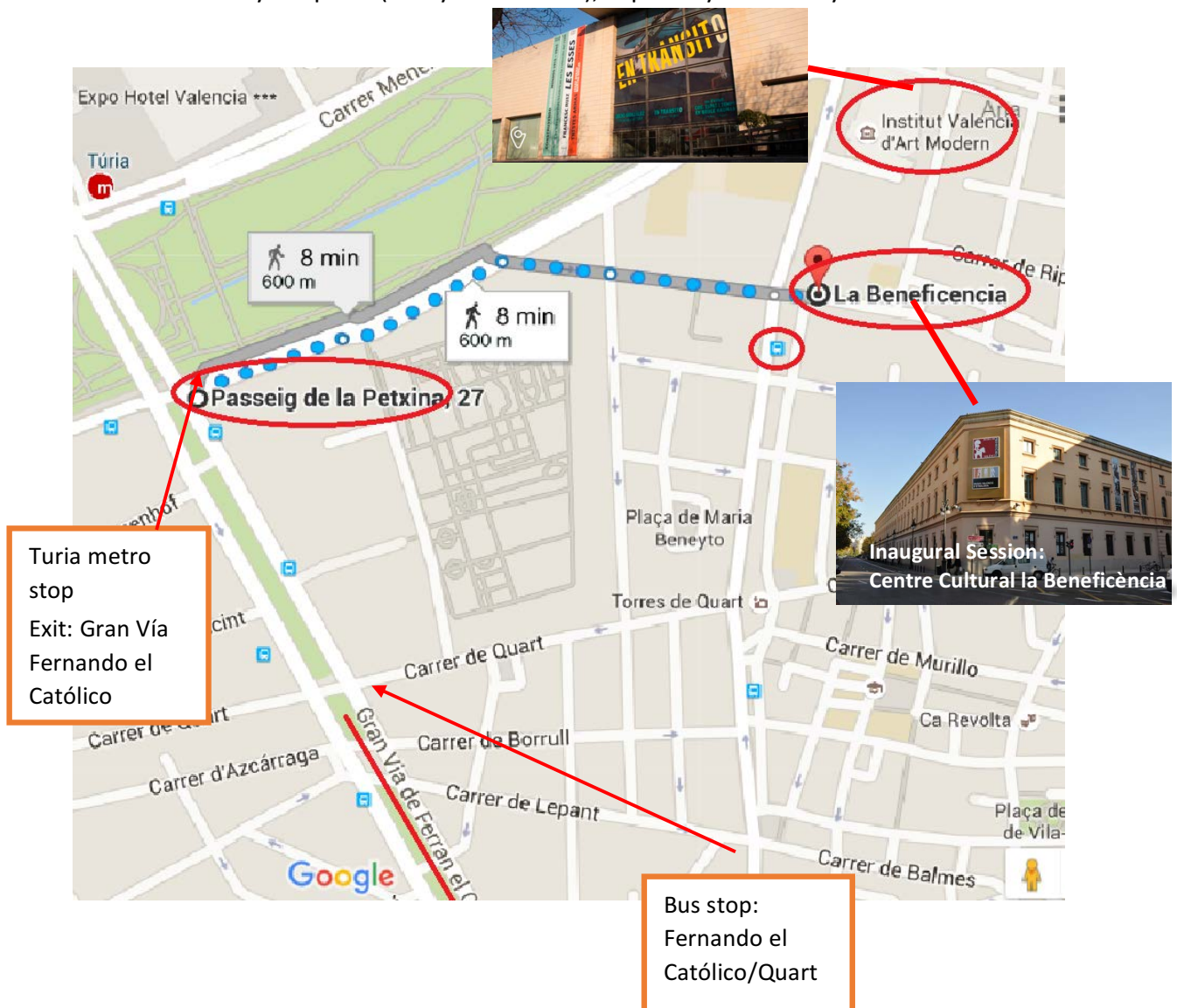
» Sunday 24th January, 16.30: Inaugural session and welcome reception

The inaugural address and the first plenary will take place at Centre Cultural La Beneficència. The welcome reception will be held at La Sucursal Restaurant at IVAM Museum (the next building).

How to get there:

From Hotel Silken Puerta Valencia, the best way to reach Centre Cultural La Beneficència is to share a **taxi** (no more than 10 euros).

You can also get there by underground (the nearest stop to the Silken Hotel is “Amistad-Casa de Salud”) or bus (line 80, stop at Aragón Avenue and get off Gran Via F. el Católico-Quart). The nearest **metro** station to La Beneficència is Turia. The best exit is Gran Vía Fernando el Católico, which you can see on the map. Note, however, that metro is not very frequent (every 20 minutes), especially on Sundays.



» Monday 25th January: Conference in Facultat de Filologia

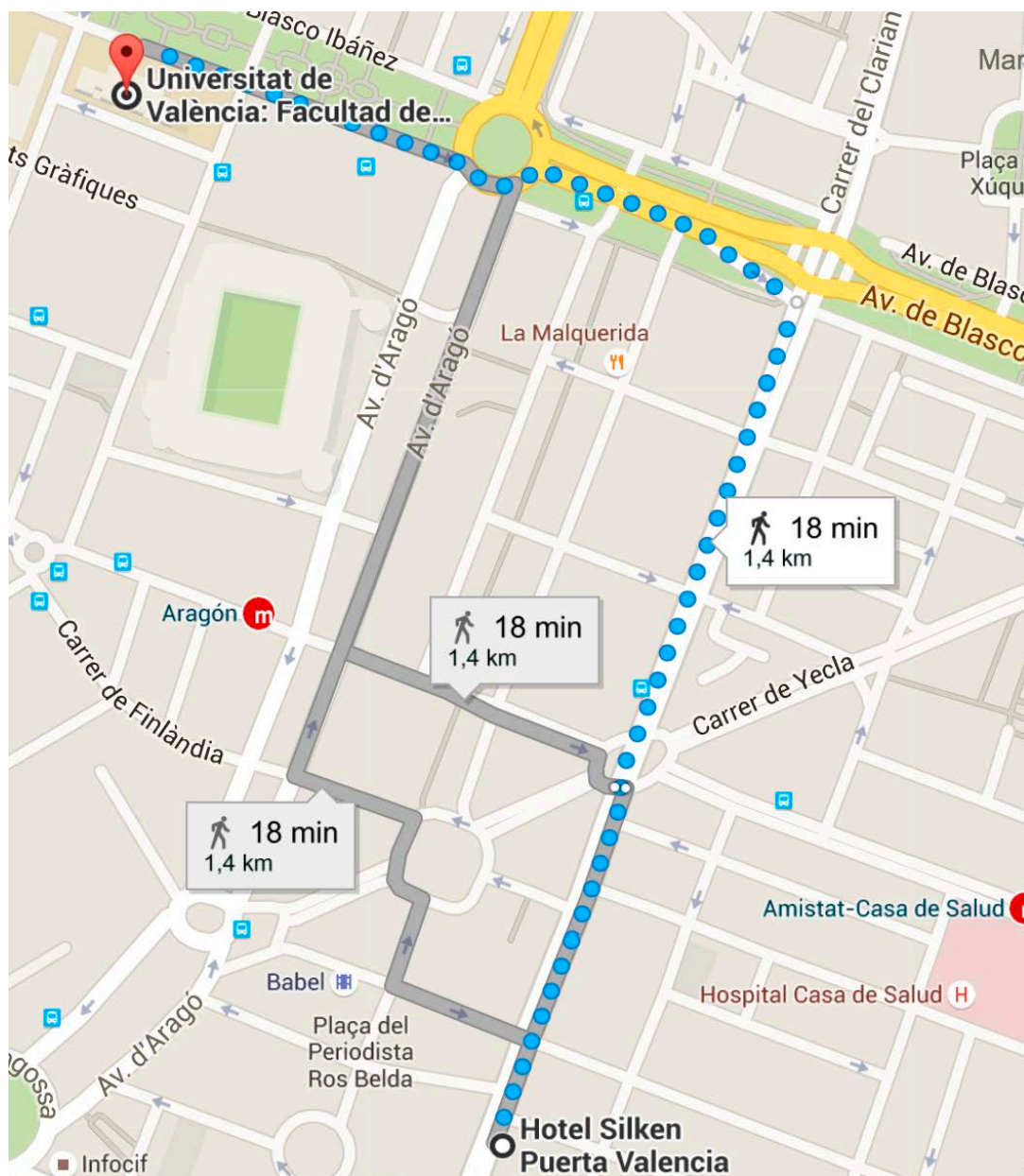
Venue: Av. Blasco Ibáñez, 32. València 46010

How to get there:

- **Walking**

The city center as well as our suggested hotels are relatively near the venue.

From Silken Hotel: Walk straight on Cardenal Benlloch street or on Av. d'Aragó until you reach Blasco Ibáñez avenue; turn left and walk straight you reach the Faculty (15-20 minutes)..



- **By underground**

Line 3. Station “Facultats”. The stairs leading to the tube are located in front of the Faculty of History, scarcely 50 m. away from the Faculty of Philology, Translation and Communication.

Line 5. Station “Aragón”. The Faculty of Philology is located 7 minutes walk from Amadeo de Saboya exit, past the Football Stadium. Line 5, stop Amistat-Casa de Salud, leads to the Silken Puerta de Valencia hotel (5 minutes walk).

Line 3 also connects the campus with the city center (stations “Xativa”, “Colon” and “Alameda.”) Line 5 also connects the campus with the city center and North Train station (station Bailén), the main train station, Joaquin Sorolla (station Joaquin Sorolla-Jesús)

- **By bus**

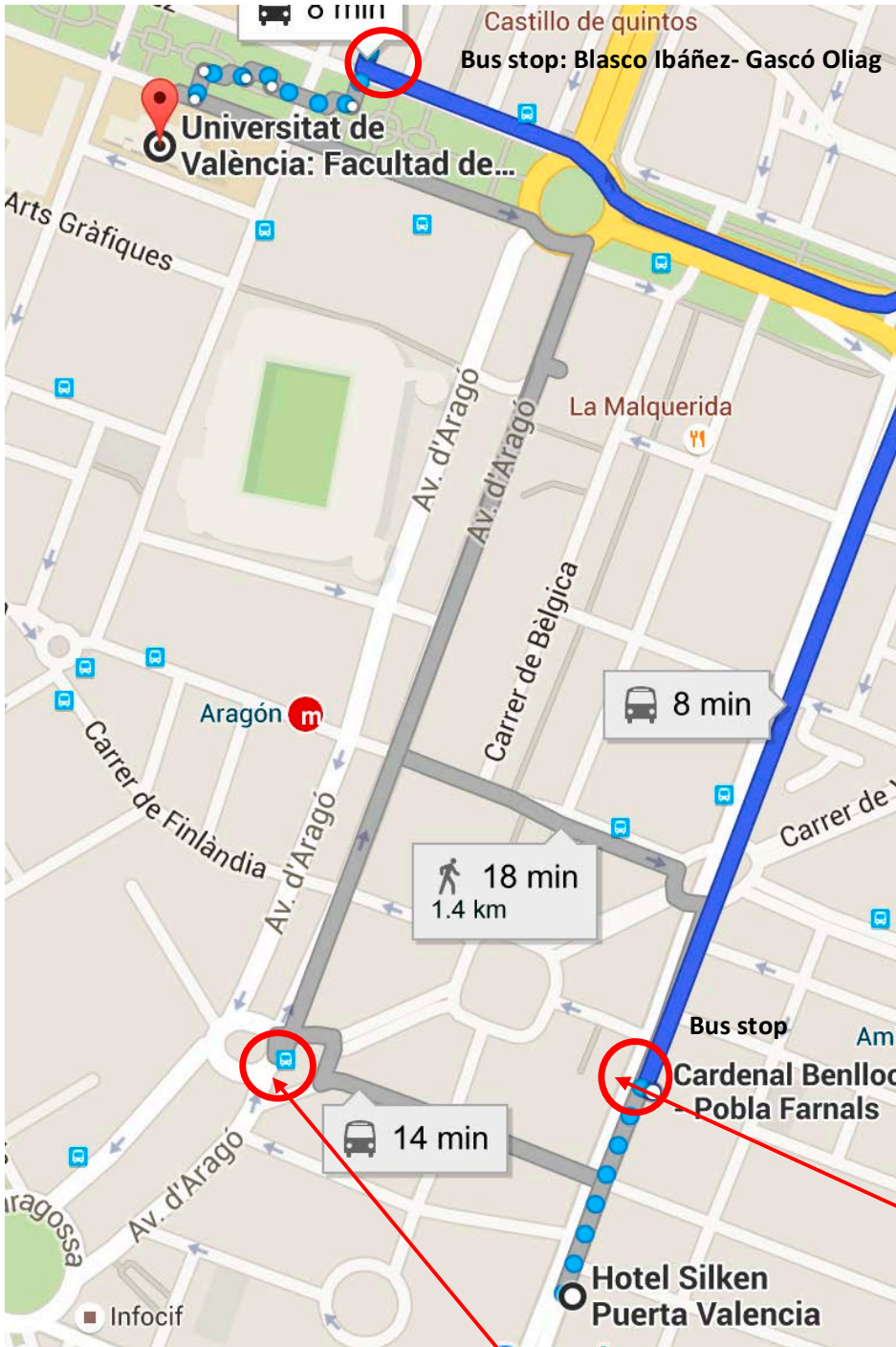
The nearest stops are located in front of the main entrance of the Faculty of Philology, Translation and Communication. Line 89 (from Cardenal Benlloch Avenue) or lines 10, 12, 79 (from Av.-d’Aragó-Xile stop) (10 -15 min). To go back, take line 80 (in front of the main entrance of the Faculty of Philology).

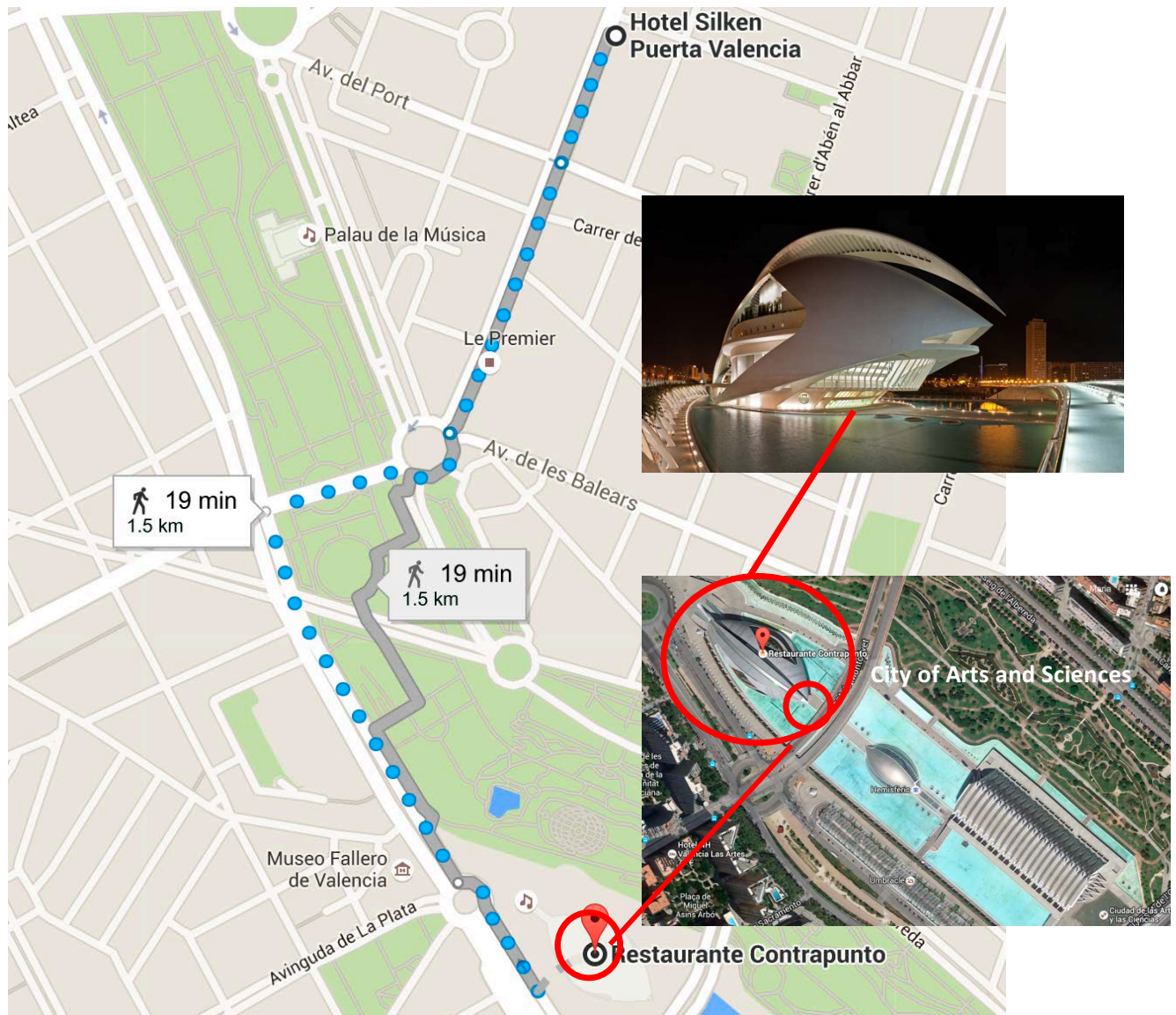
» Monday 25th January, 20:30: Conference dinner

Meeting point: Hotel Silken Puerta Valencia (20:00) or at the Restaurant

Restaurant *Contrapunto* Palau de les Arts Reina Sofia

Location: The Restaurant is located inside the building of the Palau de les Arts Reina Sofia (Palace of the Arts) in Avenue Professor López Piñero, 1, 46013 València (on the ground floor, facing the Hemispheric). Once you have reached the Palau de les Arts go downstairs and walk along the building to its east side end).

How to get: From Hotel Silken Puerta Valencia, the best way to reach Palau de les Arts Reina Sofia is to share a **taxi (no more than 10 euros)**. From the city centre, you can take the buses #13 (at Hernán Cortés-Cirilo Amorós) or #14 (at Felix Pizcueta-Cirilo Amorós stop).
